ADDENDUM**B1. Probable Cause Statement**

AND RICARDO GARCIA LIVE TOGETHER AT [REDACTED] AS BOYFRIEND AND GIRLFRIEND WITH [REDACTED] ADULT SISTER, [REDACTED], AND THREE CHILDREN FROM PREVIOUS RELATIONSHIPS. IN THE EARLY AFTERNOON OF 10817, [REDACTED] AND RICARDO HAD AN ARGUMENT WHICH RESULTED IN RICARDO LEAVING IN [REDACTED] 2004 GMC YUKON. [REDACTED] ARRIVED HOME LATER THAT DAY AND LEARNED OF THE ARGUMENT AND THE FACT THAT RICARDO LEFT WITH NOT ONLY [REDACTED] GMC YUKON, BUT THE CAR SEATS FOR THE 2 AND 3 YEAR OLD CHILDREN. [REDACTED] OFFERED TO DRIVE [REDACTED] TO LOOK FOR RICARDO AND THE CAR SEATS AND BROUGHT HER FRIEND, [REDACTED] ALONG TO HELP. THEY SECURED [REDACTED], AGE 3, AND [REDACTED] AGE 2, IN THE ADULT BELTS IN THE BACK SEAT OF [REDACTED] WHITE DODGE CHARGER. [REDACTED] BELIEVED THAT RICARDO MAY BE IN THE AREA OF 24TH STREET AND ROESER AND WHILE IN ROUTE, SUGGESTED THAT THEY STOP AT THE TA CABARET, LOCATED AT 3420 SOUTH CENTRAL, TO SEE IF HE MAY BE THERE. AS [REDACTED] PULLED BEHIND THE CLUB, SHE RECOGNIZED [REDACTED] YUKON PARKED BEHIND THE BUILDING. [REDACTED] AND [REDACTED] GOT OUT AND APPROACHED THE YUKON TO FIND RICARDO BEHIND THE WHEEL AND AN UNKNOWN FEMALE IN THE BACK SEAT BEHIND THEM. AS [REDACTED] ARGUED WITH RICARDO AT THE DRIVERS WINDOW, [REDACTED] OPENED THE REAR PASSENGER SIDE DOOR AND TRIED TO REMOVE THE CAR SEATS FROM THE BACK SEAT. THE UNKNOWN FEMALE FROM THE BACK SEAT WAS YELLING THAT THIS WAS NOT WHAT IT LOOKED LIKE AND THEY WERE THERE WITH OTHER PEOPLE. A STRUGGLE ENSUED WHEN [REDACTED] UNLOCKED THE PASSENGER DOOR AND RETRIEVED [REDACTED] PURSE AND THEN TRIED FOR THE KEYS WHICH WERE IN THE IGNITION. AFTER A STRUGGLE BETWEEN THE FEMALE, [REDACTED] AND RICARDO, RICARDO PUT THE YUKON IN REVERSE AND BACKED INTO THE PASSENGER SIDE FRONT OF [REDACTED] CHARGER WHICH WAS PARKED BEHIND THE YUKON WITH THE TWO CHILDREN STILL INSIDE. [REDACTED] SCREAMED TO RICARDO THAT THE CHILDREN WERE IN HER CAR. [REDACTED] GOT BEHIND THE WHEEL OF THE CHARGER AND MOVED IT TO A PARKING SPACE NEAR THE ALLEY SOUTH OF [REDACTED] WHERE THIS WAS HAPPENING. AT THIS POINT, [REDACTED] WAS IN THE FRONT PASSENGER SEAT AND [REDACTED] WAS IN THE PASSENGER SEAT OF THE YUKON TRYING TO GET THE CAR KEYS. RICARDO BACKED OUT OF THE SPACE, SWITCHED TO DRIVE AND ACCELERATED VIOLENTLY COLLIDING WITH THE LEFT REAR OF THE CHARGER WHICH WAS OCCUPIED BY THE TWO ADULT FEMALES AND 2 JUVENILES UNDER AGE 15 CAUSING CONSIDERABLE DAMAGE TO BOTH VEHICLES. RICARDO DROVE WEST AND TURNED AROUND IN THE LOT WHILE [REDACTED] AND [REDACTED] GOT THE CHILDREN OUT OF THE CHARGER SO RICARDO WOULD NOT INJURE THEM IF HE HIT THE CHARGER AGAIN. [REDACTED] WALKED TO THE CENTER OF

THE LOT AND RICARDO ACCELERATED TOWARD [REDACTED] STRIKING HER WITH THE DRIVERS SIDE FRONT OF THE YUKON CAUSING HER TO FALL TO THE GROUND. RICARDO PAUSED AND THEN RAN COMPLETELY OVER [REDACTED] WITH THE YUKON. RICARDO SPED DOWN THE ALLEY AND LEFT THE AREA. FIRE AND POLICE RESPONDED TO THE SCENE AND [REDACTED] WAS TRANSPORTED TO GOOD SAMARITAN HOSPITAL WHERE [REDACTED] PRONOUNCED DEATH AT 2344 HOURS. RICARDO GARCIA WAS LOCATED SLEEPING IN THE YUKON IN THE ALLEY NORTH OF THE HOME HE SHARED WITH [REDACTED] BY FAMILY MEMBERS. POLICE WERE ALERTED BY OTHER FAMILY MEMBERS AND ARRIVED TO TAKE RICARDO INTO CUSTODY AS TWO OF [REDACTED] BROTHERS FOUGHT WITH HIM IN THE BACK SEAT. RICARDO WAS TRANSPORTED TO COUNTY HOSPITAL FOR TREATMENT OF FACIAL LACERATIONS. AFTER BEING RELEASED FROM THE HOSPITAL AND UNDER MIRANDA, GARCIA AT FIRST SAID HE BLACKED OUT DUE TO BEING INTOXICATED. HE THEN ADMITTED RUNNING [REDACTED] OVER WITH HER YUKON BECAUSE HE WAS PISSED THAT SHE WAS HITTING HIM. HE REMEMBERED HITTING [REDACTED] SISTERS CAR ONLY ONCE.
