B1. Probable Cause Statement

ON APRIL 30, 17 THE LISTED VICTIMS AND THE LISTED DEFENDANT WERE AT THE DEFEND-ANTS ADDRESS OF IN THE CITY OF GLENDALE IN THE COUNTY OF MARICOPA. THE VICTIM AND THE DEFENDANT HAD BEEN IN RELATIONSHIP FOR APPROXIM-ATELY ONE YEAR AND RECENTLY BROKEN UP. THE DEFENDANT CONTACTED THE VICTIM AND ASKED HIM TO COME TO THE LISTED RESIDENCE. THE VICTIM AND ANOTHER PERSON ARRIVED AT THE LISTED RESIDENCE WHERE THE VICTIM WAS TELLING THE DEFENDANT ON THE PHONE THAT HE WAS AT THE RESIDENCE AND STANDING OUT FRONT. THE DEFENDANT CAME OUT OF THE RESIDENCE AND BEGAN TO CONFRONT THE VICTIM AT WHICH TIME THE DEFENDANT PULLED OUT A HANDGUN AND BEGAN SHOOTING AT THE VICTIM. THE VICTIM BEGAN TO RUN AWAY FROM THE RESIDENCE AND DOWN THE STREET CHASING THE VEHICLE THAT BROUGHT HIM THERE. THE VICTIM WAS ABLE TO GET IN THE VEHICLE AND BOTH VICTIMS WERE ABLE TO FLEE THE AREA IN THE VEHICLE. THE DEFENDANT WAS CONTACTED BY GLENDALE POLICE AT THE RESIDENCE AND STATED THE VICTIM WAS SHOOTING AT HER RESIDENCE. THE DEFENDANT WAS SEEN LEAVING THE RESIDENCE AS WELL AS COLLECTING THE SHELL CASING FROM THE DRIVEWAY PRIOR TO POLICE CONTACT BY THE NEIGHBORS. OFFICERS DID NOT NOTE ANY BULLET STRIKES AT THE VICTIM'S RESIDENCE NOR THE NEIGHBOR'S RESIDENCE TO THE EAST OR WEST. THE DEFENDANT DID GIVE GLENDALE OFFICERS THE BULLET CASING SHE COLLECTED. THE DEFENDANT WAS LATER, THAT SAME EVENING, STOPPED BY THE PHOENIX POLICE DEPARTMENT IN THE AREA OF THE VICTIM'S NEW RESIDENCE OF WHERE OFFICERS LEARNED THE VEHICLE THE VICTIMS LEFT THE INCIDENT FROM HAD FIVE DIFFERENT BULLET STRIKES. THE VICTIM STATED PRIOR TO RETURNING TO THIS RESIDENCE THEY HAD TO STOP AND CHANGE THE TIRE DUE TO IT BEING FLAT FROM A BULLET STRIKE. THE BULLET STRIKES ON THE VEHICLE ARE ON THE PASSENGER SIDE AND THE BACK WINDOW OF THE VEHICLE WITH STRIKES PENETRATING THE VEHICLE AND ENTERING THE FRONT PAS-SENGER SIDE AND CAB OF THE VEHICLE. THE DEFENDANT WAS DETAINED AND TAKEN TO THE GLENDALE POLICE DEPARTMENT. THE VEHICLE THE DEFENDANT WAS DRIVING WAS TOWED TO THE GLENDALE POLICE DEPARTMENT. A SEARCH WARRANT WAS DRAFTED FOR THE RESIDENCE AND THE VEHICLE THE DEFENDANT WAS STOPPED IN BY THE PHOENIX POLICE DEPARTMENT. THE DEFENDANT WAS INTERVIEWED UNDER MIRANDA AND STATED SHE WANTED TO SPEAK WITH HER ATTORNEY SINCE SHE IS CURRENTLY ON PROBA-TION. THE VICTIMS DID NOT SUSTAIN ANY INJURIES FROM THE INCIDENT. DURING THIS INVESTIGATION IT WAS ALSO LEARNED THE NEIGHBOR/VICTIM ACROSS THE STREET FROM THE DEFENDANT HAD DAMAGE TO THEIR VEHICLE AND BLOCK WALL OF THEIR RESIDENCE. ESTIM-ATED DAMAGE TO THIS VEHICLE IS APPROXIMATELY \$600 TO THE TRANSMISSION COOLER AND RADIATOR.
