B1. Probable Cause Statement ON 042217 AT 0013 HOURS I RESPONDED TO 4502 N 19TH AVENUE ON A CALL OF A FIGHT. WHEN I ARRIVED I SPOKE WITH WHO PROVIDED ME WITH THE FOLLOW-STATED THAT SHE HAD BEEN TRAVELING WITH A FRIEND, JACOB HARRIS, FROM WASHINGTON. ON THEIR TRIP THEY STOPPED AT A HOTEL AT THE 117 AND W NORTHERN AV-WENT TO SLEEP AND LEFT THE KEYS TO HER VEHICLE ON THE DRESSER. WHEN WOKE UP JACOB AND THE KEYS WERE GONE. WENT OUTSIDE AND FOUND THAT HER VEHICLE CALLED THE PHOENIX POLICE DEPARTMENT TO REPORT THE VEHICLE WAS ALSO GONE. LATER CALLED JACOB AT WHICH POINT JACOB TOLD HER HE WAS AT A CIRCLE K STOLEN. AT N 19TH AVENUE AND W CAMPBELL AVENUE. WENT TO THE CIRCLE K AND FOUND JACOB. CONTACTED THE PHOENIX POLICE DEPARTMENT TO REPORT SHE LOCATED HER VEHICLE. STATED THAT JACOB HAS NEVER DRIVEN THE VEHICLE AND THAT SHE HAS NEVER GIVEN HIM PERMISSION TO DRIVE THE VEHICLE. AT THIS TIME I SPOKE WITH JACOB WHO PROVIDED ME WITH THE FOLLOWING. JACOB STATED WAS SLEEPING SO HE LEFT IN THE VEHICLE TO GO GET BREAKFAST FOR AND HIMSELF. WHEN HE CAME BACK WAS STILL SLEEPING SO HE LEFT THE BREAKFAST IN THE ROOM AND LEFT IN THE VEHICLE AGAIN TO GO STATUE SHOPPING. WHILE HE WAS OUT HE RE-CEIVED A CALL FROM ASKING WHERE HE WAS AT. JACOB TOLD HER AND WAITED FOR HER TO ARRIVE. JACOB STATED THE HE HAD DRIVEN THE VEHICLE MANY TIMES IN THE PAST AND BELIEVED HE HAD CONSENT TO DRIVE THE VEHICLE WHENEVER HE WANTED.AFTER SPEAK-ING WITH JACOB I WAS ADVISED BY THAT SHE BELIEVED JACOB STILL HAD THE KEYS. I ASKED JACOB IF HE WOULD PULL THE ITEMS OUT OF HIS POCKETS JUST TO VERIFY THAT HE DID NOT HAVE THE KEYS. JACOB COMPLIED AND BEGAN PULLING ITEMS FROM HIS PANTS POCKET. WHEN JACOB REACHED INTO HIS BACK RIGHT PANTS POCKET AND PULLED HIS HAND OUT A SMALL CLEAR PLASTIC ZIPLOC BAGGIE FELL OUT OF THE POCKET ONTO THE GROUND. THE BAGGIE WAS THE TYPE COMMONLY USED FOR ILLEGAL DRUGS. BELIEVING THAT THERE WERE ILLEGAL DRUGS INSIDE THE BAGGIE I PICKED UP THE BAGGIE AND LOOKED IN-SIDE. JACOB IMMEDIATELY STATED THAT THE PILLS WERE XANAX AND THAT HE HAD A PRE-SCRIPTION. WHEN ASKED WHERE THE PILL BOTTLE WAS JACOB STATED HE THREW IT OUT. DUE TO JACOB HAVING A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE AND NO PROOF OF THE SUBSTANCE BEING PRESCRIBED TO HIM, JACOB WAS PLACED UNDER ARREST AT 0039 HOURS. ON A SEARCH IN-CIDENT TO ARREST, OFFICER ARMOUR 8605 LOCATED A CLEAR PLASTIC ZIPLOC BAGGIE WITH A WHITE CRYSTALLIZED SUBSTANCE INSIDE. JACOB WAS TRANSPORTED TO THE NORTHERN COM-MAND STATION WHERE OFFICER PORTER 4932 TESTED THE CRYSTALLIZED SUBSTANCE. OFFICER PORTER NOTIFIED ME THE SUBSTANCE TESTED POSITIVE FOR CRYSTAL METHAMPHETAM-INE AT 0135 HOURS. WHILE AT NORTHERN COMMAND STATION I READ JACOB HIS MIRANDA WARNINGS USING A DEPARTMENTAL ISSUED MIRANDA CARD AT 0119 HOURS. JACOB STATED HE UNDERSTOOD WITH A VERBAL YES SIR. JACOB PROVIDED ME WITH THE FOLLOWING. WHEN ASKED ABOUT THE METHAMPHETAMINE JACOB FIRST STATED THAT IT WAS . I ASKED WHY IT WAS IN HIS PANTS POCKET. JACOB STATED HE DIDNT KNOW. I STATED TO JACOB THAT IT DID NOT MAKE SENSE THAT WOULD PUT IT IN HIS PANTS AND ASKED HIM WHEN WAS THE LAST TIME HE USED. JACOB STATED HE HAD LAST USED TWO DAYS AGO. I ASKED JACOB WHERE HE GOT THE METHAMPHETAMINE AND HE STATED FROM SOME ONE OFF THE STREET. I ASKED HOW MUCH HE PAID FOR IT AND HE STATED THAT PAID FOR IT. JACOB ALSO STATED THAT HE DID KNOW THE METHAMPHETAMINE WAS IN HIS POCKET AND THAT IT WAS ILLEGAL TO POSSESS. WHEN I ASKED JACOB ABOUT THE XANAX JACOB STATED THAT HE DID HAVE A PRESCRIPTION FOR IT BUT HIS DOCTOR WAS TRYING TO CUT HIS DOSAGE BACK. JACOB FELT HE NEEDED MORE SO HE BOUGHT IT FROM SOMEONE OF THE STREET TO SUPPLEMENT HIS PRESCRIPTION. JACOB WAS LATER BOOKED INTO FOURTH AVENUE
