AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 25-102, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; REPEALING SECTION 25-122, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO MARRIAGE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:  
2       Section 1. Section 25-102, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4           25-102. Minimum age for marriage

5       A. ~~Persons~~ A PERSON WHO IS under eighteen years of age shall not  
6 marry. ~~without the consent of the parent or guardian having custody of~~  
~~such person. Persons under sixteen years of age shall not marry without~~  
~~the consent of the parent or guardian having custody of that person and~~  
~~the approval of any superior court judge in the state. When both parents~~  
~~are living the consent of either parent is sufficient. When the parents~~  
~~are living apart, the consent shall be given by the parent who has the~~  
~~custody of the minor.~~

7       B. ~~Before authorizing the marriage of a person who is under sixteen~~  
8 ~~years of age, the court:~~

9           1. ~~Shall require both parties to the marriage to complete~~  
10 ~~premarital counseling. The court may waive this requirement if the court~~  
11 ~~determines that premarital counseling is not reasonably available.~~

12           2. ~~Must find that the minor is entering into the marriage~~  
13 ~~voluntarily.~~

14           3. ~~Must find that the marriage is in the best interests of the~~  
15 ~~minor under the circumstances.~~

16           4. ~~May require that the minor continue to attend school.~~

17           5. ~~May require any other condition that the court determines is~~  
18 ~~reasonable under the circumstances.~~

19           C. ~~A marriage shall not take place under this section if it is~~  
20 ~~prohibited by the law relating to prohibited and void marriages.~~

21       B. THE CLERK OF THE SUPERIOR COURT SHALL NOT ISSUE A LICENSE TO A  
22 PERSON WHO IS UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE.
