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ADDENDUM

B1. Probable Cause Statement

THE DEFENDANT AND THE VICTIM HAVE BEEN DATING FOR THE PAST TWO YEARS AND HAVE LIVED TOGETHER FOR THE PAST YEAR. ON 02-26-17, THE DEFENDANT CALLED POLICE TO REPORT THAT HER BOYFRIEND HAD BEEN SHOT. SHE INITIALLY STATED SHE DID NOT KNOW HOW HE HAD BEEN SHOT AND STATED THAT HE HAD SIMPLY TOLD HER HE HAD BEEN SHOT AND ASKED HER TO CALL FOR MEDICAL ATTENTION. UPON THE ARRIVAL OF OFFICERS THE DE-FENDANT EXITED THE RESIDENCE AND SPOKE WITH OFFICERS. WHEN ASKED IF SHE KNEW WHAT HAD HAPPENED SHE QUICKLY STATED NO, AND THEN QUICKLY CHANGED HER ANSWER WITHOUT PROMPTING AND TOLD OFFICERS THAT SHE HAD SHOT HER BOYFRIEND AFTER LEARN-ING THAT HE HAD BEEN HAVING AN AFFAIR. WHEN ASKED IF SHE WAS STILL ARMED WITH THE GUN, SHE EXPLAINED THAT SHE HAD PLACED THE GUN ON THE COUCH. SHE ALSO STATED THAT HER BOYFRIEND HAD BEEN SLEEPING AND THAT HE DID NOT KNOW IT WAS HER WHO HAD SHOT HIM. THE VICTIM WAS TRANSPORTED TO HONOR HEALTH OSBORN TO BE TREATED FOR MULTIPLE GUNSHOT WOUNDS. THE VICTIM REPORTEDLY HAD 7 TOTAL WOUNDS ASSOCIATED WITH BEING SHOT. 2 GUNSHOT WOUNDS WERE FOUND IN HIS NECK, 1 GUNSHOT WOUND TO HIS UPPER BACK, 1 GUNSHOT WOUND TO HIS PENIS, 1 GUNSHOT WOUND TO THE LEFT THIGH, AND TWO MORE GUNSHOT WOUNDS WERE FOUND IN HIS SCROTUM. NONE OF THE WOUNDS WERE LIFE THREATENING, BUT DID REQUIRE HOSPITALIZATION. AN UNFIRED ROUND WAS ALSO LOCATED ON THE VICTIM UPON HIS ARRIVAL TO THE HOSPITAL. A .32 CALIBER HANDGUN WAS LOC-ATED UNDER THE CHAIR THE VICTIM HAD BEEN SEATED IN, WHILE HE WAS BEING TREATED BY FIRST RESPONDERS. THE VICTIM DID NOT KNOW WHO HAD SHOT HIM AND UPON QUESTION-ING STATED HE HAD NEVER HAD AN AFFAIR AND THAT HE DID NOT KNOW WHY THE DEFENDANT WOULD SHOOT HIM. THE VICTIM STATED THAT HE HAD BEEN SLEEPING WHEN THE SHOOTING OCCURRED AND THAT HE WAS INITIALLY AWOKEN BY WHAT HE BELIEVED WAS FIREWORKS, BE-FORE HE FELT EXCRUCIATING PAIN IN HIS LOWER EXTREMITIES AND REALIZING HE WAS SHOT. BASED ON THIS INFORMATION A SEARCH WARRANT WAS DRAFTED FOR THE RESIDENCE. THREE SHELL CASINGS WERE LOCATED IN THE LIVING ROOM WHERE THE VICTIM HAD BEEN SLEEPING IN A SEATED POSITION IN A CHAIR. ANOTHER ROUND THAT HAD NOT BEEN FIRED WAS FOUND BEHIND THE CHAIR THE VICTIM HAD BEEN SEATED IN. ALL OF THE ROUNDS AND CASINGS THAT WERE FOUND IN THE LIVING ROOM AND ON THE VICTIM WERE A .32 CALIBER ROUND. WHEN QUESTIONED, THE VICTIM ADVISED THAT HE OWNED THREE HANDGUNS, ALL OF WHICH WERE 9MM. THE VICTIM STATED HE DID NOT BELIEVE THE DEFENDANT OWNED A GUN, OR THAT SHE KNEW HOW TO USE ONE. DURING A SEARCH OF THE RESIDENCE A .32 CALIBER HANDGUN BOX WAS FOUND IN THE MASTER CLOSET IN A VICTORIA'S SECRET BAG NEAR THE DEFENDANT'S CLOTHING. INSIDE OF THE BAG WAS A SALES RECEIPTS FROM 02-16-17, SHOWING THAT THE FIREARM WAS PURCHASED BY THE DEFENDANT FROM CABELLA'S IN GLEND-ALE. A HANDWRITTEN NOTE ON THE RECEIPTS HAD THE CROSS STREETS TO A LOCAL SHOOT-ING RANGE. THE RECEIPTS ALSO SHOWED THE PURCHASE OF .32 CALIBER AMMUNITION WHICH WAS ALSO FOUND IN THE BAG. ANOTHER EMPTY BOX OF .32 CALIBER AMMUNITION WAS FOUND IN A PURSE BELONGING TO THE DEFENDANT. BASED ON THE FACTS THAT THE DEFENDANT HAD JUST RECENTLY PURCHASED THE FIREARM, THE FACT THAT THERE WERE GUNSHOTS DIRECTED AT THE VICTIM'S NECK NEAR HIS HEAD, AND THAT THE VICTIM WAS SLEEPING AT THE TIME OF THE SHOOTING AND NO ARGUMENT WAS TAKING PLACE, IT IS BELIEVED THAT THE DE-FENDANT INTENTIONALLY PLANNED TO SHOOT THE VICTIM WITH PREMEDITATION.
