B1. Probable Cause Statement

ON 04/03/2017, 1614 HOURS, AZDPS SGT. LESLIE ATTEMPTED TO STOP A VEHICLE FOR 80 IN THE POSTED 55 MILE PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT ZONE ON EASTBOUND I-10 AT 51ST AVEN-UE. THE VEHICLE FAILED TO YIELD AS SGT. LESLIE CONTINUED FOLLOWING ATTEMPTING TO STOP IT WITH BOTH HIS LIGHTS AND SIRENS ON. I RESPONDED AND ASSISTED CATCHING UP WITH SGT LESLIE AT 35TH AVENUE. AS THE VEHICLE NOW SLOWED DO ABOUT 35-40MPH PHOENIX PD FIREBIRD HELICOPTER AND MULTIPLE OTHER UNITS RESPONDED. SGT. LESLIE AND I CONTINUED TO ATTEMPT TO STOP THE CAR WITH OUR LIGHTS AND SIRENS ACTIVATED. THE VEHICLE CONTINUED TO VARY SPEEDS BETWEEN 35 AND 60 MILES PER HOUR. OVER THE COURSE OF THE PURSUIT 10 OR MORE TROOPERS WERE INVOLVED. DURING THE PURSUIT TROOPERS MANAGED TO SPIKE ALL FOUR TIRES BUT THE VEHICLE REFUSED TO STOP, IT ALSO ACTIVELY EVADED TROOPERS DEPLOYING THE SPIKE STRIPS. NEAR THE END OF THE PURSUIT TROOPERS TURNED OFF THEIR SIRENS AND GAVE MULTIPLE COMMANDS THROUGH THEIR VEHICLE'S P.A.. SYSTEM TO STOP AND PULL OVER, AND THAT HE WAS UNDER AR-REST. TROOPERS EVENTUALLY STOPPED THE VEHICLE BY PERFORMING A PIT MANEUVER AT GILBERT AND SR202. DURING A HIGH RISK STOP THE SUBJECT WOULD NOT FOLLOW COMMANDS TO GET ONTO THE GROUND AND WAS TAZED BEFORE BEING TAKEN INTO CUSTODY. THE SUB-JECT AS IDENTIFIED BY HIS ARIZONA LICENSE PROFILE AND MEDICAL MARIJUANA CARD AS ALLEN KELLY BARTOLI JR, DOB 06/13/1989. DURING A SEARCH OF HIS VEHICLE TROOPERS LOCATED A BLACK POUCH CONTAINING NEEDLES, MARIJUANA, A CLEAR LIQUID IN A VIAL, AND A CRUSHED CRYSTALLINE SUBSTANCE WHICH APPEARED TO BE METHAMPHETAMINE. WE ALSO LOCATED A CIGAR WHICH APPEARED TO HAVE BEEN PREVIOUSLY DIPPED IN A SUB-STANCE. DURING AN INTERVIEW WITH BARTOLI HE ADMITTED TO USING CANNABIS THAT DAY BUT DENIED USING ANY OTHER DRUGS OR METHAMPHETAMINE. BARTOLI ALSO STATED THAT THE LIQUID INSIDE HIS E-CIGARETTE WAS LIQUID THC. BARTOLI HAD MULTIPLE INJECTION SITES ON HIS ARMS WHICH APPEARED TO BE RANGING FROM ONE WEEK OLD TO WHAT AP-PEARED TO BE LESS THAN 24 OLD. BARTOLI HAD REDDEND EYES AND HIS PUPILS WERE DILATED. HIS EYES WERE SLOW TO REACT TO LIGHT AND WE MEASURED A PULSE OF 116 BEATS PER MINUTE. BARTOLI'S HANDS WHERE SWEATING AND VISIBLY WET. BARTOLI WAS INCOHERENT AT TIMES AND DAZED. BARTOLI SLOW TO RESPOND TO QUESTIONS AND DURING OUESTIONING HE WOULD ANSWER OUESTIONS WHICH WERE ASKED APPROXIMATELY 10 SECONDS EARLIER. HE OFTEN SPOKE OFF TOPIC. DURING QUESTIONING ABOUT THE PURSUIT BARTOLI TOLD US THAT HE DIDN'T SEE THE RED AND BLUE LIGHTS UNTIL WE PITTED HIM AND MADE HIM STOP. HE THEN MADE STATEMENTS ABOUT HE THOUGHT HE WAS ON A "CLOSED COURSE" AND WAS ON AN "EVALUATION." BARTOLI MADE FURTHER COMMENTS THAT HE HAD DONE NOTH-ING WRONG, PUT NO ONE IN DANGER AND DID NOT NEED TO STOP.
