**B1. Probable Cause Statement**

ON 02/04/18 AT 0226 HOURS, SCOTTSDALE PD RESPONDED TO A SHOOTING THAT HAD JUST OCCURRED AT THE INTERSECTION OF N CIVIC CENTER PLZ AND E STETSON DR IN THE SCOTTSDALE BAR DISTRICT. THE VICTIM WAS IN THE STREET WITH A GUNSHOT WOUND TO HIS HEAD. CHEST COMPRESSIONS HAD BEEN STARTED AND SCOTTSDALE FIRE FIGHTERS WHO HAD ARRIVED ON SCENE BEGAN TREATING THE VICTIM. ULTIMATELY THE VICTIM WAS TRANSPORTED TO HONOR HEALTH ER AT 7400 EAST OSBORN ROAD, SCOTTSDALE, AZ WHERE HE WAS PRONOUNCED DECEASED. WITNESSES WERE INTERVIEWED BY OFFICERS AND IT WAS LEARNED THAT PRIOR TO THE SHOOTING THE VICTIM AND HIS FRIENDS WERE RIDING IN A GOLF CART TAXI CAB ON SOUTHBOUND CIVIC CENTER PLZ APPROACHING STETSON DR. THE VICTIM WAS SEATED IN THE BACK OF THE GOLF CART IN A REAR FACING SEAT WITH TWO OTHER SUBJECTS. AS THE GOLF CART TRAVELED SOUTHBOUND IT WAS FOLLOWED BY A RED COLORED COUPE THAT WAS BELIEVED TO BE A SCION TC AS DESCRIBED BY WITNESSES. THE DRIVER OF THE VEHICLE WAS OBSERVED DRIVING THE VEHICLE AND ALMOST STRIKING THE REAR OF GOLF CART ON NUMEROUS OCCASIONS AND THEN BACKING OFF AS THEY TRAVELED SOUTH ON STETSON DR. THE GOLF CART CAME TO A STOP FOR A STOP SIGN AT STETSON DR AND THE RED PASSENGER CAR DROVE UP TO THE BACK OF THE GOLF CART ALMOST STRIKING THE GOLF CART. THE VEHICLE WAS CLOSE ENOUGH FOR THE VICTIM TO PUT HIS FOOT ON THE HOOD. THE VICTIM THEN STOOD UP AND EXITED THE GOLF CART AND INTO THE STREET. THE VICTIM APPROACHED THE DRIVER'S SIDE DOOR OF THE VEHICLE. THE VICTIM WAS OBSERVED LEANING DOWN TOWARD THE OPEN WINDOW OF THE DRIVER'S DOOR WHEN THE DRIVER WHO WAS OBSERVED HOLDING A HANDGUN OUT THE WINDOW FIRED THE HANDGUN SHOOTING IN THE HEAD. A .40 CALIBER SPENT SHELL CASING WAS DISCOVERED IN THE CURB ON THE FAR WEST SIDE OF THE STREET, JUST NORTH OF STETSON DR. FOLLOWING THE SHOOTING THE RED PASSENGER CAR IMMEDIATELY DEPARTED FROM THE INTERSECTION TO EASTBOUND STETSON DR WHERE THERE WAS EVIDENCE THAT THE VEHICLE STRUCK OTHER VEHICLES. A RED COLORED HOUSING TO THE PASSENGER SIDEVIEW MIRROR WAS LOCATED ON THE SIDE OF THE STREET AS WELL AS MATCHING PIECES IN THE CENTER OF THE STREET. THE VEHICLE WAS THEN CAPTURED ON THE DASH MOUNTED VIDEO CAMERA OF A TAXI CAB VEHICLE TURNING ONTO SOUTHBOUND 75TH ST. THE RED PASSENGER COUPE WHICH HAD THE SAME CHARACTERISTICS OF A RED SCION TC COUPE PASSED THE TAXI BY DRIVING DOWN THE CENTER LINES BETWEEN CONGESTED NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND BAR TRAFFIC. AS THE VEHICLE PASSED BY THE TAXI THE AUDIO CAPTURED ON THE VIDEO WAS CONSISTENT WITH APPROXIMATELY THREE VEHICULAR ACCIDENTS. VARIOUS DAMAGED VEHICLE DEBRIS WAS LOCATED AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS THROUGHOUT THE ROADWAY ON 75TH ST THAT WAS CONSISTENT WITH WHAT WAS HEARD ON THE VIDEO. THE RED SCION TC THEN LEFT THE AREA IN AN UNKNOWN DIRECTION. STILL PHOTOGRAPHS CREATED FROM THE TAXI CAB VIDEO WERE RELEASED TO THE LOCAL MEDIA WITH INFORMATION REGARDING THE HOMICIDE AND THE OUTSTANDING SUBJECT AND VEHICLE. THE SCOTTSDALE POLICE DEPARTMENT 911 OPERATOR RECEIVED A CALL FROM A SUBJECT THAT IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS THE DEFENDANT AND PROVIDED HIS BIRTH DATE. HE STATED THAT HE WAS CALLING ABOUT A SHOOTING INCIDENT IN SCOTTSDALE. THE DISPATCHER ASKED IF HE WAS A WITNESS AND HE STATED HE WAS THE SUSPECT. WHEN ASKED IF HE WAS THE PERSON WHO SHOT THE VICTIM HE STATED THAT WAS CORRECT. SHE ASKED IF THE GUN WAS IN HIS CAR AND HE STATED THAT IT WAS NOT, IT WAS IN HIS HOUSE. HE THEN GAVE HIS HOME ADDRESS AS [REDACTED], [REDACTED]. THE DISPATCHER ASKED WHERE HIS VEHICLE WAS, AND HE STATED THAT THE VEHICLE WAS AT HIS HOUSE AS WELL. THE DEFENDANT ADVISED THAT HE WAS AT THE 4TH AVENUE JAIL TO TALK TO SOMEONE ABOUT THE INCIDENT AND HAD BEEN TOLD TO CALL SCOTTSDALE. THE DEFENDANT WAS ULTIMATELY DETAINED BY THE PHOENIX PD AND TRANSPORTED TO THE CITY OF SCOTTSDALE WHERE HE IS CURRENTLY BEING DETAINED AT THE PD DETENTION CENTER, [REDACTED], SCOTTSDALE, ARIZONA. A QUERY OF THE ARIZONA MOTOR VEHICLE DIVISION RE-VEALED THAT THE DEFENDANT HAD AN ARIZONA DRIVER LICENSE WITH AN ADDRESS AT [REDACTED], PHOENIX, ARIZONA. THE DEFENDANT IS ALSO THE REGISTERED OWNER OF A 2016 SCION THREE DOOR PASSENGER VEHICLE BEARING ARIZONA LICENSE PLATE [REDACTED]. A LICENSE PLATE READER QUERY WAS CONDUCTED WITH THE REGISTRATION INFORMATION

ADDENDUM (cont'd)

DURING WHICH THERE WAS A PHOTOGRAPH OF THE REAR OF THE VEHICLE WITH THE LICENSE PLATE CONFIRMING THE EXTERIOR COLOR OF THE VEHICLE IS RED. DURING A POST MIRANDA INTERVIEW WITH THE DEFENDANT HE ADMITTED TO PUTTING A LOADED .40 CALIBER SMITH AND WESSON HANDGUN IN HIS 2016 RED SCION TC TO BRING WITH HIM TO THE SOUTH SCOTTSDALE CLUBS ON THE EVENING OF 02/03/18. THE DEFENDANT BEGAN THE EVENING AT A CLUB IN SCOTTSDALE WHERE HE HAD AN ALTERCATION WITH SECURITY STAFF. THE ALTERCATION RESULTED IN THE DEFENDANT HAVING HIS SHIRT TORN AND NUMEROUS ABRASIONS TO HIS RIGHT HAND, HIS CHEST, HIS NECK, AND HIS FACE. THE DEFENDANT ATTEMPTED TO GET INTO ANOTHER CLUB ACROSS THE STREET, HOWEVER, SECURITY STAFF THERE WAS NOTIFIED OF HIS ALTERCATION. THE DEFENDANT THEN LEFT TO ANOTHER CLUB WHERE HE DID NOT LIKE HIS DRINK AND LEFT. THE DEFENDANT THEN REALIZED THAT HE LOST HIS CELLULAR TELEPHONE. THE DEFENDANT DECIDED HE WAS GOING TO GO HOME FOR THE NIGHT AND RETURNED TO HIS VEHICLE. THE DEFENDANT BEGAN DRIVING SOUTHBOUND ON AN UNKNOWN STREET AND OBSERVED TWO MALE SUBJECTS, ONE OF WHICH WAS THE VICTIM, AND A FEMALE RIDING ON THE BACK OF A GOLF CART FACING HIM. ONE OF THE MALES WAS SAYING THINGS TO HIM BUT HE COULD NOT TELL US WHAT HE WAS SAYING. THE VICTIM WAS SAYING UNKNOWN THINGS TO HIM BUT NOT AS MUCH. THE GOLF CART STOPPED AT A STOP LIGHT. THE DEFENDANT STATED THAT HE DID NOT GET CLOSE TO THE CART AND THE VICTIM KICKED THE FRONT OF HIS VEHICLE BUT DECIDED LATER THAT THERE WAS NO DAMAGE. THE VICTIM THEN EXITED THE CART AND APPROACHED THE DRIVER'S SIDE DOOR OF HIS VEHICLE. THE VICTIM DOES NOT SAY ANYTHING AND APPROACHES WITH HIS HANDS UP AND EMPTY IN THE AIR. THE DEFENDANT THEN DESCRIBED THE VICTIM AT HIS DRIVER'S DOOR AND OPEN WINDOW WHERE THE VICTIM WITH HIS HANDS DOWN MOVED HIS UPPER BODY AND HEAD IN A FORWARD MOTION TOWARD THE DEFENDANT. THE DEFENDANT STATED THAT HE FELT THREATENED AND JUSTIFIED IN GRABBING HIS UNHOLSTERED HANDGUN FROM HIS CENTER CONSOLE AREA, POINTING IT AT THE VICTIM, AND PULLING THE TRIGGER. THE DEFENDANT NOTED THAT HE DIDN'T THINK THERE WAS A ROUND IN THE CHAMBER BECAUSE HE DID NOT TYPICALLY KEEP ONE THERE. THE DEFENDANT STATED THAT THE VICTIM WAS NOT THERE AFTER HE FIRED AND DID NOT KNOW WHERE HE WENT. HE STATED THAT HE THEN DROVE AWAY FROM THE SCENE AND ADMITTED TO STRIKING OTHER VEHICLES WITH HIS VEHICLE AND CAUSING DAMAGE TO HIS PASSENGER SIDE MIRROR. THE DEFENDANT DECIDED TO TURN HIMSELF IN WHEN HE OBSERVED THE MEDIA COVERAGE AND PHOTOGRAPHS OF HIS VEHICLE. A SEARCH WARRANT AT THE DEFENDANT'S RESIDENCE RECOVERED A 40 CALIBER HANDGUN, THE RED SCION WITH DAMAGE, AND THE CLOTHING HE HAD BEEN WEARING.
