Andres Reyes and the victim Bridget Charlebois resided together as boyfriend and girlfriend in [REDACTED] between July of 2013 and February 2014. Bridget Charlebois is a quadriplegic, confined to a wheel chair and is unable to care for or defend herself. This condition is verified by her primary care physician and the Maricopa County Medical Examiner.

Andres Reyes admits to being the fiancé to Bridget Charlebois and at the time of this offense employed by Blue Thumb Staffing to provide care for Bridget Charlebois. Andres Reyes admits that he was trained in CPR, First Aid and the Article Nine The Rights of the Disabled. This admission is confirmed by Blue Thumb Staffing and training records Blue Thumb Staffing.

Count: Vulnerable Adult Abuse 13-3623

Between 07/15/13 and 12/31/13 Andres Reyes shot Bridget Charlebois a vulnerable adult with an 'air soft' simulated semi-automatic hand gun which discharges a 6 MM plastic BB. Bridget Charlebois is a quadriplegic, confined to a wheel chair and unable to defend herself. This abuse occurred in the City of Glendale at [REDACTED], in Maricopa County Arizona. There is sufficient force in this 'air soft' gun to warrant the use of eye protection and protective clothing. A 6 MM pellet strike from the weapon has sufficient impact to leave a welt and penetrate the skin if protective measures are not taken. Independent witnesses witnessed this offense and Andres Reyes has admitted to family members of the victim that he shot Bridgette Charlebois with the air soft gun.

Between 11/1/13 and 12/1/13 Andres Reyes shot Bridget Charlebois a vulnerable adult with an 'air soft' simulated semi-automatic hand gun which discharges a 6 MM plastic BB. Bridget Charlebois is a quadriplegic, confined to a wheel chair and unable to defend herself. This abuse occurred in the City of Glendale at [REDACTED], in Maricopa County Arizona. There is sufficient force in this 'air soft' gun to warrant the use of eye protection and protective clothing. A 6 MM pellet strike from the weapon has sufficient impact to leave a welt and penetrate the skin if protective measures are not taken. An additional independent witness witnessed this offense and Andres Reyes has admitted that he shot Bridgette Charlebois with the air soft gun.

Between 11/28/13 and 12/25/13 Andres Reyes abandoned Bridget Charlebois a vulnerable adult without food or water for over twelve hours in a diaper soiled with urine and feces. Bridget Charlebois is a quadriplegic, confined to a wheel chair and unable to care for herself. This abuse occurred in the City of Glendale at [REDACTED], in Maricopa County Arizona. An independent witness witnessed this event and rescued Bridget Charlebois from circumstances that her primary care physician described as likely to produce death or serious physical injury.

**Count Murder 13-1104.A**

Between 1/30/14 and 2/2/14 Andres Reyes failed to provide medical assistance or activate Emergency Medical Services to Bridget Charlebois resulting in her death. This homicide occurred in the City of Glendale at [REDACTED], in Maricopa County Arizona. Andres Reyes has made admissions to being the caregiver at the time Bridget Charlebois fell ill claiming that he did not know what to do and or that Bridget Charlebois refused treatment. There is evidence in the form of training records and policy and procedures provided by Blue Thumb Staffing to support that Andres Reyes was trained to summon medical assistance by calling 911 and activating EMS. There is medical evidence found at autopsy by the Maricopa County Medical Examiner to support the fact that proper medical intervention might have prevented the death of Bridget Charlebois.

**Count Murder 13-1104.A**

Between 1/30/14 and 2/2/14 Andres Reyes failed to provide medical assistance or activate Emergency Medical Services to Bridget Charlebois resulting in her death and the death of her unborn child (Isaiah Charlebois). This homicide occurred in the City of Glendale at [REDACTED], in Maricopa County Arizona. Andres Reyes has made admissions to knowing that Bridget Charlebois was three months pregnant. There is evidence in the form of training records and policy and procedures provided by Blue Thumb Staffing to support that Andres Reyes was trained to report the pregnancy of a client, summon medical assistance by calling 911 and activating EMS. Had the pregnancy been reported Bridget Charlebois would have received treatment for a high risk pregnancy which could have resulted in the birth of a normal child. There is medical evidence found at autopsy by the Maricopa County Medical Examiner to support the fact that at the time of her death, Bridget Charlebois carried a full term male fetus with no apparent defects and that proper medical intervention might have prevented the death of the unborn child of Bridget Charlebois.
