ADDENDUM

B1. Probable Cause Statement

ON MONDAY, JANUARY 23, 2017, AT APPROXIMATELY 0111 HOURS, THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY (DPS), OPERATIONAL COMMUNICATIONS (OPCOMM), RECEIVED NUMEROUS 9-1-1 EMERGENCY CALLS FROM WITNESSES REPORTING A BLACK JEEP FOUR DOOR STATION WAGON DRIVING THE WRONG DIRECTION - SOUTHBOUND IN THE NORTHBOUND LANES - ON IN-TERSTATE 17 FROM STATE ROUTE 303, IN PHOENIX, ARIZONA. SEVERAL REPORTING PARTIES ADVISED THEY WERE FORCED TO TAKE EVASIVE ACTION TO AVOID BEING STRUCK HEAD-ON BY THE JEEP. SOME WITNESSES REPORTED THE JEEP STEERED TOWARD THEIR VEHICLES, NEARLY COLLIDING AND FORCING THEM TO TAKE EVASIVE ACTION TO AVOID COLLIDING WITH IT. THE JEEP WAS TRAVELING AT A SPEED DESCRIBED BY WITNESSES, AS BEING APPROXIMATELY 100 MILES PER HOUR WHILE DRIVING THE WRONG DIRECTION ON THE CONTROLLED ACCESS HIGHWAY. AS THE JEEP WAS DRIVEN SOUTH IN THE NORTHBOUND TRAFFIC LANES, A VICTIM COLLIDED WITH A CONCRETE BARRIER WALL WHEN HE TOOK EVASIVE ACTION TO AVOID COL-LIDING HEAD-ON WITH THE SUSPECT VEHICLE. ELAM CONTINUED DRIVING SOUTHBOUND IN THE NORTHBOUND TRAFFIC LANES UNTIL AT APPROXIMATELY 0122 HOURS, A HEAD-ON COLLI-SION OCCURRED ON NORTHBOUND INTERSTATE 17 AT UNION HILLS, BETWEEN THE JEEP AND ANOTHER VICTIM. THE VICTIM'S VEHICLE, AND THE JEEP, WERE TOTALED. WHEN ARIZONA DPS TROOPER S. JACOBS, HP5818, ARRIVED AT APPROXIMATELY 0124 HOURS, THE DRIVER OF THE JEEP WAS OBSERVED TO BE EMERGING FROM THE DRIVER SEAT OF THE JEEP. HE IDENTIFIED THE DRIVER BY HIS VALID ARIZONA DRIVER LICENSE AS ALLEN MICHAEL ELAM, DATE OF BIRTH NOVEMBER 28, 1991. ELAM IS THE REGISTERED OWNER OF THE JEEP. TROOPER JACOBS OBSERVED ELAM'S EYES TO BE RED AND BLOOD SHOT, AND HE SWAYED AS HE STOOD. ELAM SEEMED DISORIENTED. TROOPER JACOBS ADMINISTERED AN EYE TEST AND OBSERVED NO CLUES OF IMPAIRMENT. A PRELIMINARY BREATH TEST AT THE SCENE INDIC-ATED A BREATH ALCOHOL CONCENTRATION OF 0.000%. TROOPER JACOBS WAS UNABLE TO AD-MINISTER ANY OTHER STANDARD FIELD SOBRIETY TESTS TO ELAM BECAUSE HE WAS TRANS-PORTED FOR MEDICAL TREATMENT. TROOPER JACOBS AUTHORED A SEARCH WARRANT FOR THE PURPOSES OF OBTAINING A SPECIMEN OF BODILY FLUIDS FROM ELAM TO FURTHER AN IM-PAIRED DRIVING (DUI) INVESTIGATION. THE WARRANT WAS GRANTED BY THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONER P. WILLIAMS OF THE MARICOPA COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT. TROOPER JACOBS FOLLOWED THE AMBULANCE TRANSPORTING ELAM TO HONOR HEALTH JOHN C LINCOLN HOSPITAL LOCATED AT 250 EAST DUNLAP AVENUE IN PHOENIX, ARIZONA. ELAM WAS MOVED INTO THE TRAUMA AREA OF THE EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT. A HOSPITAL PHLEBOTOMIST, WHO WAS COL-LECTING A BLOOD SPECIMEN FOR MEDICAL PURPOSES, PROVIDED TROOPER JACOBS WITH A PORTION OF THE BLOOD. TROOPER JACOBS, A QUALIFIED LAW ENFORCEMENT PHLEBOTOMIST, ALSO CONDUCTED A PHLEBOTOMY BLOOD DRAW PER THE SEARCH WARRANT HE HAD OBTAINED. TROOPER JACOBS ALSO OBTAINED A URINE SPECIMEN FROM A CONTAINER OF URINE, PRO-DUCED BY ELAM, OF WHICH THE MEDICAL STAFF WAS GOING TO DISPOSE. THE URINE SPECI-MEN WAS PLACED IN A "MEDTOX" KIT, AND IT INDICATED NO DRUGS TO BE PRESENT. TROOPER JACOBS CONDUCTED AN INTERVIEW WITH ELAM. ELAM DENIED CONSUMING ALCOHOL OR DRUGS. HE SAID THE LAST TIME HE HAD USED MARIJUANA WAS APPROXIMATELY TWO WEEKS AGO. ELAM STATED HE HAD BEEN DIAGNOSED BY A PSYCHIATRIST AS HAVING SCHIZO-PHRENIA, HOWEVER HAS NOT RECEIVED TREATMENT FOR IT. HE SAID HE HAD BEEN INVOLUN-TARILY ADMITTED TO THE HOSPITAL ABOUT A WEEK AGO AFTER HE THREATENED TO ASSAULT HIS SISTER'S BOYFRIEND WHOM HE BELIEVED WAS CHEATING ON HER. HE SAID THE PHOENIX POLICE BELIEVED ELAM WAS A DANGER TO HIMSELF AND OTHERS. ELAM SAID HE WAS A STU-DENT AT A LOCAL COLLEGE, AND HAD MET A FEMALE THERE WHOM HE HAD DATED OVER THE LAST THREE MONTHS. SHE SUDDENLY STOPPED SPEAKING TO HIM, AND HE SAID HE THOUGHT SHE WAS "CHEATING" ON HIM. HE SAID, "I FIGURE IF SHE DOESN'T THINK I'M WORTH ANYTHING, THEN I DON'T THINK I'M WORTH ANYTHING." HE DECIDED HE WOULD ATTEMPT TO COMMIT SUICIDE BY DRIVING THE WRONG DIRECTION ON THE INTERSTATE AND COLLIDING WITH ANOTHER VEHICLE. WHEN TROOPER JACOBS ASKED WHY HE DID NOT ATTEMPT SUICIDE USING A MEANS THAT DID NOT INVOLVE HURTING ANOTHER PERSON. ELAM SAID HE THOUGHT HE MIGHT MEET SOMEONE ELSE ON THE INTERSTATE WHO "WANTED TO DIE WITH" HIM. ELAM ADMITTED HE WAS DEPRESSED BECAUSE OF THE BREAK-UP WITH THE FEMALE WHOM HE WAS DATING AND NO LONGER WANTED TO LIVE. ELAM SAID HE HAD BEEN TEXTING HER EARLIER IN THE EVENING, USING HIS CELLULAR TELEPHONE, BUT SHE WOULD NOT ANSWER HIM. TROOPER JACOBS SEIZED THE TELEPHONE ELAM SAID HE USED TO TEXT HER. THE JEEP ELAM WAS DRIVING WHEN THE COLLISION OCCURRED WAS TOWED FROM THE SCENE TO THE TRI STAR

ADDENDUM (cont'd)

TO YARD IN PHOENIX, ARIZONA. AFTER ELAM WAS RELEASED FROM THE HOSPITAL, HE WAS ARRESTED AND INTERVIEWED. AFTER WAIVING HIS MIRANDA RIGHTS, ELAM ADMITTED INTEN-TIONALLY DRIVING THE WRONG DIRECTION ON THE INTERSTATE BECAUSE HE WANTED ATTEN-TION. HE SAID HIS PARENTS AND FAMILY HAD BEEN FIGHTING, AND HE FELT IF HE CRASHED AND KILLED HIMSELF, HE WOULD BE REMEMBERED. HE ALSO SAID HE HAD RECENTLY BROKEN UP WITH A FEMALE WHOM HE WAS DATING, AND HE WANTED HER TO FIND OUT HE HAD BEEN INVOLVED IN A CRASH. ELAM SAID THE VICTIM WITH WHOM HE COLLIDED WAS "JUST WHAT (HE) WAS LOOKING FOR." ELAM ADMITTED KNOWING IT WAS UNLAWFUL AND WRONG TO DRIVE THE WRONG WAY ON THE INTERSTATE, AND TO PLACE OTHERS AT RISK OF INJURY OR DEATH. ELAM SAID HE POSTED, ON SOCIAL MEDIA, HIS INTENTION TO ATTEMPT TO CRASH WRONG-WAY ON THE HIGHWAY, PRIOR TO DRIVING. HE SAID HE KNEW IF HE DROVE THE WRONG WAY, THERE WAS A SIGNIFICANT CHANCE SOMEONE WOULD DIE. HE ALSO SAID HE FULLY EXPECTED TO DIE WHILE DRIVING WRONG-WAY ON THE INTERSTATE.
