ADDENDUM**B1. Probable Cause Statement**

ON 08/07/18 AT APPROXIMATELY 1834 HOURS, OFFICERS RESPONDED TO THE RESIDENCE LOCATED AT 515 WEST HOLLY STREET AFTER A CHECK WELFARE CALL WAS PLACED. THE CALL DETAILS WERE A FEMALE STATED SHE WAS GOING TO KILL SOMEONE AND THE POLICE SHOULD RESPOND. WHEN OFFICERS ARRIVED A MALE, LATER IDENTIFIED AS THE SUSPECTS FATHER EXITED THE RESIDENCE. HE INFORMED OFFICERS THAT HIS DAUGHTER AND WIFE WERE STILL INSIDE THE RESIDENCE AND IT WAS HIS DAUGHTER WAS ARMED WITH A KNIFE. OFFICERS CALLED THE WIFE OUTSIDE AND CONFIRMED THERE WAS NO ONE OTHER THAN THE SUSPECT/ DAUGHTER INSIDE, THE OFFICERS ENTERED. UPON THEIR ENTRY THEY OBSERVED A FEMALE HOLDING A BUTCHER KNIFE, 12 IN LENGTH STANDING IN THE LIVING ROOM. THE SUSPECT ASKED THE OFFICERS IF THEY HAD A GUN, AND WHEN TOLD THE OFFICER HAD A TASER, SHE INSTRUCTED THEM TO TAKE OUT THE GUN. THE SUSPECT MADE A SWIPING MOTION WITH THE KNIFE, ARGUED WITH THE OFFICERS, THEN TOOK STEPS TOWARDS THE OFFICER CLOSEST TO THE FRONT DOOR OF THE RESIDENCE WITH THE KNIFE RAISED. ONE OF THE OFFICERS DISCHARGED HIS FIREARM TOWARDS THE SUSPECT, BUT DID NOT STRIKE THE SUSPECT. THE OTHER OFFICER DEPLOYED HER TASER AND STRUCK THE SUSPECT, CAUSING THE SUSPECT TO DROP THE KNIFE. THE SUSPECT WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY AND TRANSPORTED TO A NEARBY HOSPITAL TO BE EVALUATED. AFTER RECEIVING A MEDICAL CLEARANCE, SHE WAS TRANSPORTED TO PHOENIX POLICE VIOLENT CRIMES BUREAU WHERE SHE WAS INTERVIEWED. INVESTIGATORS INTERVIEWED THE SUSPECTS PARENTS AND DISCOVERED THE SUSPECT HAD THREATENED BODILY HARM TOWARDS BOTH SUBJECTS, UTILIZING THE SAME 12 BUTCHER KNIFE. THE SUSPECT WOULD HOLD THE KNIFE NEAR THE PARENTS AND STATE SHE WAS GOING TO KILL THEM. THE SUSPECT WAS INTERVIEWED, AND DURING THE POSTMIRANDA INTERVIEW, SHE ADMITTED TO CALLING 911 WITH THE INTENTION OF HAVING THE OFFICERS KILL HER. SHE ADMITTED TO BEING IN POSSESSION OF THE KNIFE, AND DURING THE CONVERSATIONS WITH THE OFFICERS, WAS UNWILLING TO CHANGE HER MIND AND DROP THE KNIFE NEAR HER FEET AFTER MULTIPLE COMMANDS TO DROP THE KNIFE. SHE ADMITTED TO LEANING FORWARD AND THROWING THE KNIFE IN AN UNDERHAND MOTION, KNEE CAP LEVEL, TOWARDS THE NORTH END OF THE LIVING ROOM. THIS WAS ALSO IN THE DIRECTION OF THE MALE OFFICER ARMED WITH HIS DUTY WEAPON. THE SUSPECT ADMITTED SHE WAS IN MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS AND HAS ONGOING TREATMENT AND MEDICATIONS FOR HER MENTAL HEALTH WITH A PRIOR DIAGNOSIS OF BIPOLAR TENDENCIES AND ADD/ADHD. SHE ADMITTED TO ARGUING WITH HER PARENTS PRIOR TO THE ENCOUNTER WITH THE OFFICERS AND BEING EXTREMELY MAD, AND UPON THE ARRIVAL OF THE OFFICERS WAS ANGRY AND STUBBORN AND DID NOT COMPLY WITH THEIR COMMANDS. SHE WAS UNABLE TO EXPLAIN WHY SHE TOOK THE STEPS SHE DID TODAY OTHER THAN HER DESIRE TO MAKE THE OFFICERS SHOOT HER.
