1. Summarize and include the facts which establish probable cause for the arrest for the crimes charged:

On 051118, the reporting party reported the Westwood High School at 945 W Rio Salado had been burglarized and a laptop computer and charging cord was taken. Campus surveillance video showed a male entering the unlocked cafeteria door and placing the laptop computer in his backpack before leaving. The male in the surveillance video is a young black male, wearing a backpack, and carrying a longboard skateboard. The male is also wearing a football jersey with the name OLDHAM on the back. I recalled from previous burglary cases in 2017 that the suspect, who was identified as the defendant, would ride a longboard during the burglaries. The defendant was convicted of committing eight burglaries in 2017 as a juvenile.

On 060518 patrol officers were dispatched to 1133 S Dobson Rd reference an assault. As a result, the defendant was arrested for assault and transported to the Mesa city jail. I was notified of the arrest and responded to the jail in order to interview the defendant for the above case.

Post Miranda, the defendant admitted to entering the Westwood High School campus after hours and checking door handles until he found one that was unlocked. The defendant admitted to

entering the cafeteria door and taking a laptop computer which was sitting inside the cafeteria. The defendant said he then took the laptop to Tempe where he gave it to someone for free near the lightrail. He admitted he commits burglaries because he is bored. The defendant said he was previously a student at Westwood High School but was not a student at the time the burglary occurred.

I believe probable cause exists to charge the defendant with the above charges.
