B1. Probable Cause Statement

DROVE IT.

ON AUGUST 19, 2018, AT APPROXIMATELY 0130 HOURS, DPS TROOPER YOUNG RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF AN UNKNOWN INJURY CRASH ON SOUTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 143 (SR143) NEAR INTERSTATE 10 (I10). TROOPER YOUNG ARRIVED ON SCENE AND LOCATED A SILVER 2015 NISSAN PASSENGER CAR ON THE EASTBOUND I10 OFF RAMP TO SR143. TROOPER YOUNG WAS CONTACTED BY A WITNESS WHO STATED A WHITE MALE HAD WALKED AWAY FROM THE VEHICLE. TROOPER YOUNG REQUESTED A TOW TRUCK AND CLEARED THE SCENE AFTER THE VEHICLE WAS TOWED FROM THE SCENE. IN THE EVENING OF 08-19-2018, , DATE OF BIRTH 01/09/1997, CALLED THE PINAL COUNTY SHERIFF OFFICE TO REPORT HE WAS A PASSENGER IN THIS CRASH AND FLED THE SCENE WITH THE DRIVER, WHO HE IDENTIFIED AS TOMMY SIKES.
